

INFORMATION NOTICE FOR PATIENTS/RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS

This Information notice may be modified by the Servier Group, to take into account any changes from applicable laws and regulations, as well as in our activities. The changes will appear on this page, that we invite you to consult regularly.

Purpose of this Information notice for patients/research participants (the “Information notice”): this Information notice is intended to provide a clear and transparent information on how your personal data is processed in the context of your relationship with the Servier Group as a patient/research participant.

1. Who is the data controller?

The Servier Group is made up of several entities. The Servier entity acting as data controller may differ depending on the purpose pursued.

The Servier entity acting as data controller is indicated in the table below. It is also indicated in the information that may have been given to you via another channel.

2. Why do we collect your personal data and on which basis? Which data are we talking about?

This Information notice describes activities for which we need to use your personal data, according to the appropriate legal basis.

We only use data that is strictly necessary for the purposes we are pursuing.

3. How long do we keep your personal data?

The Servier Group entity acting as data controller will only keep your personal data for as long as is necessary to achieve the purposes pursued in this Information notice. More specifically:

Purpose pursued	Data retention period
Management of clinical research activities	We keep your personal data until the product studied is marketed, or until 2 years after the last publication of the results of the research or, if the results are not published, until the final research report is signed. Your data is then archived for a period in accordance with current legislation.
Management of health monitoring activities	We keep your personal data for 30 years after the end of the marketing authorisation concerned; the data is then deleted or archived in an anonymous form, unless otherwise stipulated by mandatory local regulations.
Management of requests for medical information	We keep your personal data for a period of 10 years from the date we receive your request.
Management of quality defect reports	We keep your personal data for a period of 10 years from the date we receive your request.

<p>Early access and compassionate access</p>	<p>Early access: We keep your personal data for a maximum of 2 years following publication by the French National Authority for Health (“Haute Autorité de Santé” or “HAS”), where applicable after consultation with the French National Agency for the Safety of Medicines and Health Products (“Agence Nationale de Sécurité du Médicament et des produits de santé” or “ANSM”), of the summary of the latest summary report. The data will then be archived for a maximum period of 10 years from the date on which the drug is withdrawn from the market.</p> <p>Compassionate access: We keep your personal data for a maximum of 2 years following ANSM approval of the summary of the last summary report. The data will then be archived for a maximum period of 10 years from the date of expiry of the compassionate access authorisation.</p>
<p>Compassionate access framework</p>	<p>We keep your personal data for a maximum of 2 years following ANSM approval of the summary of the last summary report.</p> <p>The data will then be archived for a maximum period of 10 years from the expiry date of the compassionate prescription framework.</p>
<p>Servier Group internal events (expert patient interviews)</p>	<p>We keep your personal data for 5 years from the end of the contractual relationship.</p>
<p>Record of switchboard’s calls</p>	<p>We keep your personal data for a maximum period of 6 months from recording.</p>
<p>Pre-litigation and litigation management</p>	<p>We keep your personal data for the duration of the professional relationship, then for the statute of limitations (civil, commercial, etc.) and until the time limits for legal recourse have been exhausted.</p>

4. How do we secure your personal data?

We put in place adequate technical and organisational measures to ensure security, integrity and confidentiality of your personal data.

These measures are designed with the aim of protecting personal data against unauthorised access, loss, destruction or alteration. In implementing these measures, we take into account the technologies available, the costs

of implementation, as well as the nature, context and purposes of the processing of personal data and the risks to the rights and freedoms of the persons concerned.

5. Do we share your personal data

Your personal data processed by the entities of the Servier Group will only be accessible by a limited list of employees of the Servier entities concerned, on a need-to-know basis or when required by law.

Your personal data may also be transmitted to partners with whom the entities of the Servier Group collaborate in order to provide the expected services.

Finally, the entities of the Servier Group may communicate upon request your personal data to the competent authorities, such as public health authorities.

6. Do we transfer your personal data internationally?

The Servier Group is made up of entities located throughout the world. It also works with partners and subcontractors located in many countries throughout the world.

Your personal data may therefore be transferred for the purposes described above to recipients located in a country that does not offer an adequate level of protection. In such a case, the Servier Group will take all necessary measures and guarantees to ensure the security of such transfers (such as the conclusion of European Commission Standard Contractual Clauses).

7. What are your rights?

According to the legal basis for the concerned purpose and when the applicable law provides it, you have the following rights:

- Request access to your personal data
- Update, correct or delete your personal data
- Request that some of the personal data you gave us be provided to you, or to another data controller, in a commonly used and machine-readable format (right to portability of your personal data)
- Define post-mortem directives
- Restrict or object to the processing of your personal data
- Withdraw your consent
